Must appreciate the importance of confidentiality and be committed to the ideal of educational equity. Must be willing to drive DEF mini-van to transport children. Background check and DMV check required.

Mentor Program Duties

 Recruit, screen, select and train mentors for the Foundation's two mentor programs (one for elementary-aged kids, one for high school-aged kids)

- Promote mentoring programs within the community
- Update and maintain mentor database and student records
- Engage and support mentors on a regular basis and troubleshoot issues as they arise
- Work with mentees/families to identify goals and/or needs
- Identify and create connections with opportunities within our community that are specific to the needs of the mentees
- Plan and host educational and enrichment events and activities for the mentees
- Reach out to potential business partners who want to offer opportunities for our mentees
- Drive DEF van to transport mentees to events and activities

Other Program Duties

- Work closely with the Director of Programs and Partnerships to provide support for programs, events and initiatives
- Coordinate meetings for program-specific teams and committees
- Help promote programs in the community
