Pam creates engaging arts integrated workshop and residency programs in printmaking, papermaking and book arts that incorporate observation concept drawing with the engineering production processes of the art form. Nature and cultural historical stories continue to inspire her art making and teaching points of entry offering a natural alignment with art integration.

Her process-focused programs feature learning foundation skills, support inquiry discovery learning, promote creative risk-taking that render original student works. Residency programs deepen individual student learning and offer collaborative production of compilation learning projects culminating in the production of a public work of art for the hosting institution.

Pam is currently a rostered teaching artist with the Georgia Council for the Arts, South Carolina and Mississippi Arts Commissions. She recently served on the Governor's Task Force for Arts Learning. She is also a featured professional development presenter for school systems, museums and art councils.

Pam's workshops and residencies are developed specific to the school site's needs. Her project based "STEAM" programming features printmaking, papermaking and book arts. Workshop activities generate original student works. Residency projects provide deeper individual learning and offer collaborative production compilation learning projects culminating in the production of a public work of art for the hosting institution.

Pam has developed /implemented curriculum-integrated art education programs for museums, art centers and schools K- 12 for over 30 years. She is currently rostered with South Carolina Arts Commission, Georgia Council for the Arts, Mississippi Arts Commission, and recently served on the Governor's Task-Force for Arts Learning

Teaching credentials include; Discipline Based Art Education Getty Southeast Center for Education in the Arts, Art Therapy Georgia Council on Child Abuse; "Talents Unlimited" gifted certification, Character Through the Arts Bernstein Artful Learning. I continue to share my passion for mark making teaching adult art classes at the Campbell Folk Arts School in North Carolina.
